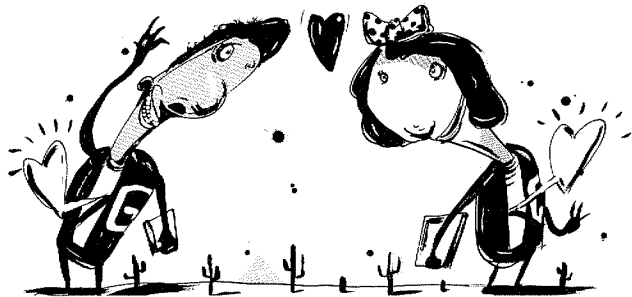


THE DATING GAME
